Thank you for considering continuing your police career with the Civil Nuclear Constabulary (CNC). An opportunity has arisen for the role of Chief Superintendent and applications are invited from substantive Chief Superintendents, and Superintendents on promotion.

Our ambition is be recognised nationally and internationally as the leading policing organisation for the armed protection of civil nuclear material and the critical national infrastructure of the United Kingdom.

We are one of only three fully armed police forces in the United Kingdom and we play a unique role in the wider policing family. Our primary duty is keeping the nation's civil nuclear material safe, both on the sites we protect, and in transit across the globe. We patrol the communities in proximity to the sites we protect and support our Home Office police colleagues with a range of policing duties.

The CNC is a significant contributor to the Strategic Armed Policing Reserve and stands ready to deploy armed officers in support of national policing responses to counter terrorism and other high-profile events.

We have a strong international reputation, working with partners in the United States of America and Japan. We are also expanding our operational delivery and now provide armed policing at a number of non-nuclear infrastructure sites and on cross channel passenger ferries.

We are determined to maintain the highest standards of professional behaviour and have invested heavily in our Professional Standards and Vetting teams. We want to invest in leaders and work as a team to create a culture where every member of staff, regardless of their background, feels safe, respected, and listened to.
